Intermediate // Advanced



As an apprentice you will learn how to install plumbing and heating systems into new and existing buildings. The Intermediate Apprenticeship will cover how to maintain and repair existing systems and equipment. The Advanced Apprenticeship will cover gas systems, domestic cold water systems, water regulations and electrical work on domestic plumbing and heating. At this level, you will expand and develop existing foundation knowledge and skills in plumbing and heating.

What qualifications, experience or skills do I need?

The Intermediate Apprenticeship is well suited to individuals who have no prior experience or knowledge of plumbing and heating systems, whilst the Advanced Apprenticeship is suited to individuals who have previous industry experience or who have already completed the Intermediate level Apprenticeship.

What is the expected duration?

Intermediate – 24 months

Advanced – 24 months

How will I be assessed?

You will be expected to complete assignments and online exams to demonstrate that you have the necessary knowledge and skills. You will also be assessed in the workplace through observations, witness testimonies and personal statements, overseen by an Assessor. This information will be incorporated into a portfolio giving evidence of competency in your job role.

Progression from this Apprenticeship and future prospects

When you achieve the Intermediate Apprenticeship you can develop your knowledge and skills further by progressing to study the Advanced Apprenticeship. Upon successful completion of the Advanced Apprenticeship, you can register on a relevant industry Certification Scheme for example CIPHE (Chartered Institute of Plumbing and Heating Engineering).
