Intermediate // Advanced



The Intermediate Apprenticeship covers areas such as health and safety, building methods, interpreting drawings, building solid and cavity walls plus cladding. As a result, you will expand and develop your foundation knowledge and skills in brickwork. At Advanced level, you will develop these skills further by learning how to erect, repair and maintain complex masonry structures.

What qualifications, experience or skills do I need?

The Intermediate Apprenticeship is well suited to individuals who have no prior experience or knowledge of brickwork techniques. The Advanced Apprenticeship is suited to individuals who have existing relevant knowledge and skills or have completed the Intermediate Apprenticeship.

What is the expected duration?

Intermediate – 18 months

Advanced – 30 months

How will I be assessed?

You will be assessed in the workplace through observations, witness testimonies and personal statements, overseen by an Assessor. This information will be incorporated into a portfolio giving evidence of competency in your job role. In addition to this you will take a number of on-line assessments to demonstrate your knowledge and understanding of the theory side of the qualification.

Progression from this Apprenticeship and future prospects

After achieving the Intermediate Apprenticeship you can develop your knowledge and skills further by progressing to study the Advanced Apprenticeship. Upon completion of the Advanced Apprenticeship you can progress into a career as a site supervisor or continue your studies onto a Higher Apprenticeship in Construction.
