Intermediate // Advanced



At Intermediate level, you will develop knowledge and skills relating to: safe and efficient receipt, storage, handling and dispatch of goods in a warehousing and logistics environment. The Advanced Apprenticeship is designed to develop existing knowledge and skills. At this level, you should have a degree of independence and responsibility over your own job role and will typically have some supervisory responsibility. The Advanced Apprenticeship will develop skills required for you to become an effective warehouse supervisor.

What qualifications, experience or skills do I need?

The Intermediate Apprenticeship is well suited to individuals who have no prior experience or knowledge of warehousing. At Advanced level, you should have an excellent understanding of the policies and procedures required when working in a warehousing and logistics environment. Apprentices need to have excellent team working and communication skills.

What is the expected duration?

Intermediate - 12 months minimum

Advanced – 12 months

How will I be assessed?

You will be assessed in the workplace through observations, witness testimonies and personal statements, overseen by an Assessor. This information will be incorporated into an e-portfolio giving evidence of competency in your job role.

Progression from this Apprenticeship and future prospects

When you achieve the Intermediate Apprenticeship you can further develop your knowledge and skills by progressing to study the Advanced Apprenticeship. After completion of the Advanced Apprenticeship, you may progress to study leadership and management qualifications.
