# Wood Occupations Bench and Site Joinery

Intermediate // Advanced



At Intermediate level, you will learn how to manufacture structural carcassing components, windows, doors, stairs and units including marking out, machining and assembling. At Advanced level, you will further develop the skills, knowledge and experience required to carry out a range of joinery work to the standards agreed by leading industry bodies.

## What qualifications, experience or skills do I need?

The Intermediate Apprenticeship is well suited to individuals who have no prior experience or knowledge of joinery, whilst the Advanced Apprenticeship is designed for individuals who have prior industry experience or who have achieved the Intermediate level Apprenticeship.

## What is the expected duration?

**Intermediate** – 18 months

**Advanced** – 30 months

## How will I be assessed?

You will be assessed in the workplace through observations, witness testimonies and personal statements, overseen by an Assessor. This information will be incorporated into an e-portfolio giving evidence of competency in your job role. In addition to this you will complete a variety of on-line and paper exams to demonstrate that you have the necessary knowledge and skills.

## Progression from this Apprenticeship and future prospects

After achieving the Intermediate Apprenticeship you can develop your knowledge and skills further by progressing to study the Advanced Apprenticeship. Upon completion of the Advanced Apprenticeship you can progress into a career as a site supervisor or continue your studies onto a Higher Apprenticeship in Construction.
