A Structured Approach

Four Business Administration apprentices work in the office and a further four are completing an apprenticeship in Warehousing. AESSEAL operate a rotating work environment for all their learners to give them experience across all aspects of the job and differing customer demands.

Within Business Administration the apprentices are moved around different back office disciplines and international customer groups. The warehousing apprentices move around all the tasks required by the operation and within 12 months they've completed their initial NVQ and covered every aspect of their roles from packing and despatching to product inspection, assembly and build.

The whole experience has been a very positive one for Stores Co-ordinator, Paul Fancutt. “Having the apprentices has certainly improved all our processes and it means we have a more flexible, multi-functional work force. We can move staff around to accommodate shifts in demand in different areas and can process our orders more effectively and efficiently.”

“It keeps us on our toes and enables us to plan better. We're constantly training our staff, so over a period of time we have developed more formalised instructions on processes and customer requirements to support the needs of their learning.”
